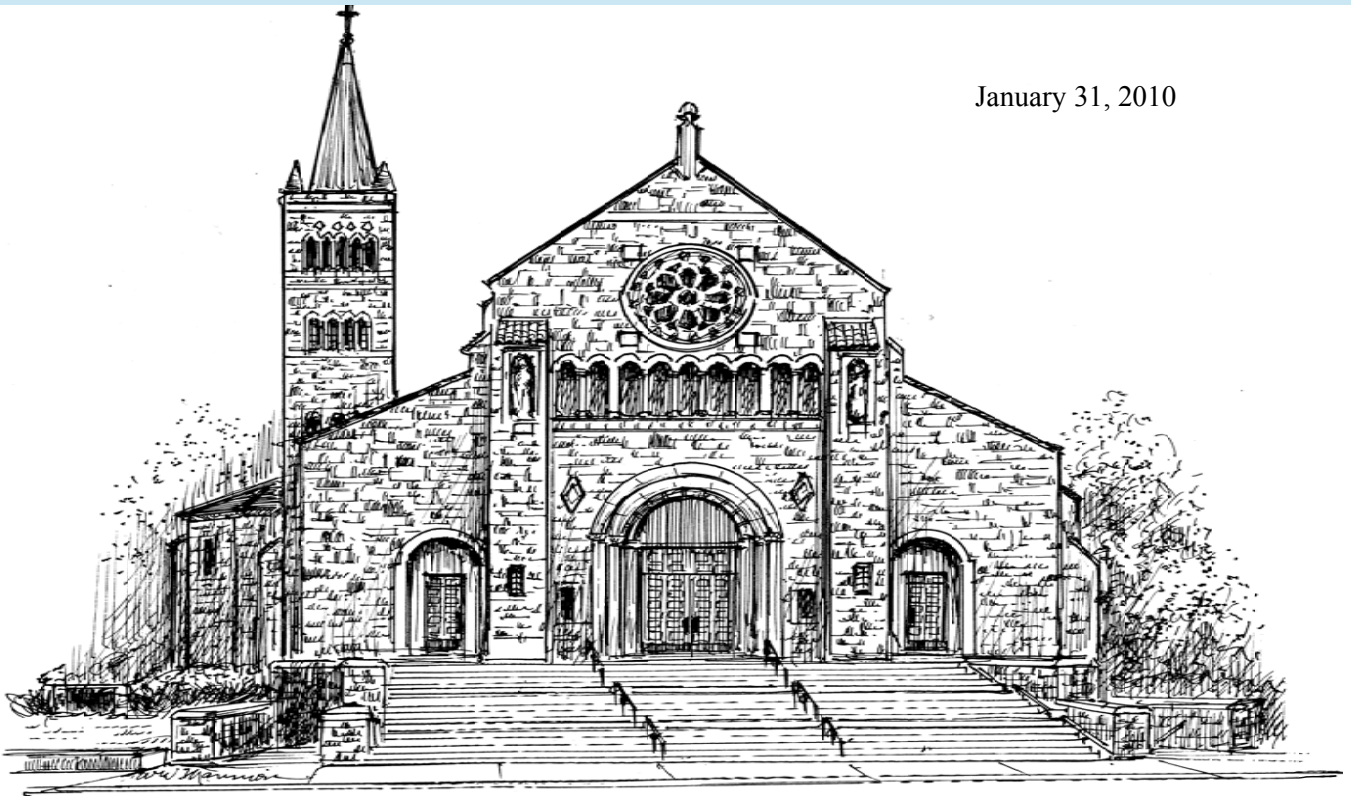

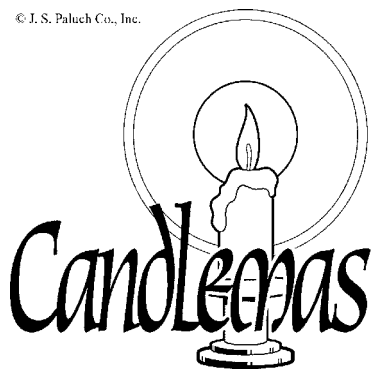

# Feast Day February 2

Presentation of the Lord

## FEAST OF THE WEEK

At the end of the 4th century, a woman named Etheria made a pilgrimage to Jerusalem. Her journal, discovered in 1887, gives an unprecedented glimpse of liturgical life there. Among the celebrations she describes is the Epiphany (January 6), the observance of Christ's birth, and the gala procession in honor of his Presentation in the Temple 40 days after his birth -- February 15. (Under Mosaic Law, a woman was ritually "unclean" for 40 days after childbirth, when she was to present herself to the priests and offer sacrifice -- her "purification." Contact with anyone who had brushed against mystery -- birth or death -- excluded a person from Jewish worship.) This feast emphasizes Jesus' first appearance in the Temple more than Mary's purification.

The observance spread throughout the Western Church in the 5th and 6th centuries. Because the Church in the West celebrated Jesus' birth on December 25, the Presentation was moved to February 2, 40 days after Christmas.

In Luke's account, Jesus was welcomed in the temple by two elderly people, Simeon and the widow Anna. They embody Israel in their patient expectation; they acknowledge Jesus as the long-awaited Messiah. Early references to the Roman feast refer to it as the feast of St. Simeon, the old man who burst into a song of joy which the Church still sings at day's end.
